



Employment Opportunity Water Treatment Plant Operator Full time Position

Job Summary:

Reporting to the Director of Public Works, the Water Treatment Plant Operator (WTPO) will be responsible for overseeing the operation of Mistawasis First Nation's water treatment and waste water facilities.

This process is managed through regular quality control measures, testing and reporting procedures.

Duties:

- Operate and monitor control systems used in filtration, treatment and distribution of water
- Perform backwash
- Operate and monitor sewage and waste water disposal control systems
- Review, sample, record and report water quality as required
- Check flow meter gages and other recording instruments to measure water output, consumption levels, bacterial content, chlorine, and fluoride levels
- Collect waste and sewage samples as required
- Test and chlorinate wells as required
- Adjust specialized equipment to ensure water quality
- Monitor plants to ensure pumps, motors, filters chlorinators and other equipment are in good operating condition and report needed repairs
- Complete checks on all treatment facilities
- Complete and maintain logbooks, records and reports
- Other duties as assigned

Minimum Qualifications for Position

- Grade 12
- Water Treatment Plant Operator Certification is mandatory (Level 1, 2, 3)
- Experience working in a multi-tasking environment
- Drivers license and reliable vehicle
- Training in First Aid, WHMIS, TDG and related safety tickets an asset
- Experience working in trades related job is an asset
